

Working out your GPA

- * Each mark has a value from 1 to 4
- * Add each mark and divide by 16 (4 units x max. 4)
- Each semester has a total of 4 units (or subjects), each year 8, the degree a total of 24 (8 x 3) $\,$
- To work out your GPA at any stage, divide the total sum of your final marks by the number of units completed; to work out your average as a %, divide

 - * $10 \div 16 = 62.5\%$ or **Pass** / **GPA** is $10 \div 4 = 2.5$

There is always a cost '\$'

* Cost per **Unit** = \$2,015

* Cost per **Semester** = \$8,060

* Cost per Week = \$671.66

* Cost per **Unit per Week** = \$167.91

* Cost per **Hour** = \$55.97

Networking


- * Start now!
